

St. Paul PCCW Meeting
July 14, 2014
Minutes

1. The meeting started at 6:11pm with Sue leading us in prayer. The Minutes followed with a correction. The Vicariate Fall Meeting will be the 4th Saturday (25th) and not the 3rd Saturday. Joyce made a motion to approve the corrected minutes and Sue seconded it. All were in favor.

6. Ruth Ann talked about the "Craft Social" on Tuesdays. She said that it is going well. Last month there were 8 ladies who attended. After July Ruth Ann said it would be good to have a session every other week. One of the projects is a quilt. Once it is to a certain point Donna Thoma said she would sew it together. It was decided to do a couple projects at a time to accomplish more. We discussed coordinating of our PCCW meeting with the "Craft Social" once a month. It was also discussed having the PCCW meeting on Wednesday and have couple older children to babysit so other ladies of the parish can attend. This will be discussed in more detail after we know the RE schedule as not to interfere.
