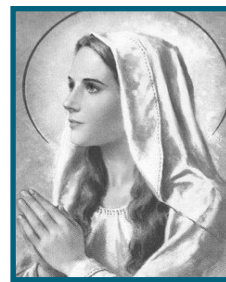

**Baptisms:** Parents, please register to become a parish member at least three months prior to having your baby baptized. Please contact the Parish Office for baptismal preparation. The next parent and god parent class will be in February.

**Marriage:** Couples are asked to notify the parish office at least six months in advance. Catholics must be confirmed and active in the faith. Wedding times are to be scheduled no later than 1:00 p.m. Even if a couple plan to choose their own vocalist, they are still required to meet with Fr. Andrew Kurz at least six months in advance.

\*Children of families in the parish should be registered upon turning 18 or upon high school graduation.
