Marriage: Couples are asked to notify the parish office at least six months in advance. Catholics must be confirmed and active in the faith. Wedding times are to be scheduled no later than 1:00 p.m. Even if a couple plan to choose their own vocalist, they are still required to meet with Fr. Andrew Kurz at least six months in advance.
